BENEFITS OF A RIBBON CUTTING

- Provision of ceremonial big scissors and ribbon for the ribbon-cutting ceremony
- Professional photography services to capture the event
- Invitation extended to local officials for participation
- Availability to address questions and inquiries from attendees
- Draft a press release and will send it out once approved by your business contact

- **Designate a Contact Person:** Choose a reliable individual to coordinate with the Chamber and oversee event logistics.
- **Promotional Materials:** If you have designed promotional flyers or materials, share them with the Chamber for additional exposure.
- **Social Media Ads:** Run targeted ads on social media platforms to reach a broader audience and generate buzz around the event.
- **Invitations:** Send personalized email and paper invitations to clients, employees, friends, family, and past, present, and future customers.
- **Branding:** Consider ordering banners and signage to enhance brand visibility and create a cohesive event atmosphere.
- **Giveaways:** Offer branded giveaway items or door prizes to incentivize attendance and foster goodwill among guests.
- **Speakers and Tours:** Designate speakers for the event and consider offering guided tours or product demos to showcase your business.
- **Refreshments:** While not required, providing food and beverages can enhance the guest experience and encourage networking.
- **Sign-In Sheet:** Have a sign-in sheet for guests with a line for email addresses to facilitate follow-up communication.
- **Thank You Notes:** Send personalized thank-you emails or notes to attendees, speakers, and special guests to express appreciation for their participation.
- **Post-Event Press Release:** Following the event, collaborate with the Chamber to draft a post-event press release highlighting key takeaways and successes.

Q: WHEN SHOULD I BEGIN TALKING TO THE CHAMBER ABOUT MY EVENT?

A: BEGIN THE CONVERSATION AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE RIBBON CUTTING. THIS ALLOWS THE CHAMBER TO CONFIRM THE DATE, ADD IT TO THE CALENDAR, AND SHARE IT WITH MEMBERS

Q: WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO HAVE A RIBBON CUTTING?

A: RIBBON CUTTINGS ARE BEST ON TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, OR THURSDAY BETWEEN 12:30 PM AND 2:00 PM. THE CHAMBER IS NOT ABLE TO ASSIST WITH RIBBON CUTTINGS ON THE WEEKEND OR AFTER 5:00 PM.

Q: HOW SHOULD I PREPARE FOR MY SPEECH?

WE RECOMMEND A 3-5 MINUTE SPEECH. THIS CAN BE AN OVERVIEW OF THE BUSINESS, STEPS YOU'VE TAKEN TO PREPARE FOR THIS DAY, AND AN EXPRESSION OF GRATITUDE.
